Raffle Guidelines: 2023-2024



General Information

The raffle is a Club fundraiser that helps raise funds for the club and also provides players an opportunity to raise funds to cover club dues and/or team fees, travel, etc.

Raffle Ticket Distribution

Tickets will be distributed to the team manager on Signing Day July 1st. The club will issue each team enough tickets for 18 players. Each player will be issued \$150 of tickets in increments of 4 \$25 tickets and 10 \$5 tickets by the manager. For additional tickets please contact the Solar office.

Selling Tickets

- Every competitive player (U11+), including Seniors, are required to participate in the Raffle.
- All players are required to sell \$150 of tickets. Any ticket sales over and above the \$150 required may be applied to the club dues, team fees, travel, etc.
- The manager may or may not participate in the raffle. If he/she participates, those funds can be applied to club dues, team fees, etc.
- Players who are children of a Solar coach are also required to participate.
- All scholarship players are responsible for selling raffle tickets. This gives a fundraising
 opportunity to all scholarship players to be able to help with fees.
- Parents can purchase the tickets themselves or reach out to family and friends.
- Tickets are to be sold for face value.
- The purchaser must complete the information at the top of the ticket. The seller keeps the stub and returns the ticket part to the purchaser which is used to claim their prize if they win.
- The club will send an invoice to the manager for the team for \$150 per player minus 1 player, the manager's child only. Example 1 Team,1 Manager =\$150 minus on the invoice, 1 Team,2 Mangers \$150 minus on the invoice, etc. THE CLUB WILL INVOICE TEAMS ON SEPTEMBER 1ST. The deadline for payment of the invoice is September 15th.

Accounting for Players Funds and Raffle Stub

- The required \$150 Raffle amount should be added to the team's dues collected by the manager.
- When your players are finished selling tickets and the funds are accounted for, the player has several options: Note: This pertains to any monies sold over and above the required \$150.
- If club dues or team fees are paid in full, the funds can be reimbursed to the player.
- If club dues or team fees are not fully paid, funds can be applied to either.
- The stub and all monies must be returned to the team manager. The manager will keep track of the player's ticket sales and monies.

Raffle Drawing – October 18th, 2023

In October, you will be sent instructions on how to turn in your team's raffle stubs so they can be included in the drawing. The drawing takes place live on the Solar Soccer Club Facebook page. All prizes must be claimed by May 2024.
